Immediate Openings:

Part-time Youth/Adult Program Coordinator:

This program is geared towards High School and older youth/adults for social activities hosted on site and in the community. Group runs once or twice per month on weekend nights for 2-3 hours. Your responsibility would be to organize activities and outings for this age group as well as supervise the event.
